Based on the results of this evaluation, the products listed do not contain prohibited substances listed in Article 4 of EU Directive 2002/95 EC on the restriction in the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment, as amended by Commission Decision of 18 August 2005 (2005/618/EC), Commission Decision of 13 October 2005 (2005/717/EC), and Commission Decision of 21 October 2005 (2005/747/EC). Under this directive lead, mercury, cadmium, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyls and polybrominated diphenyl ethers are prohibited in the manufacture of electrical and electronic equipment with the exception of those items listed in the Annex of the Directive.
